As a college undergrad, Amber Harris began advocating for women's issues through a part-time job at Project Safe, an Athens, Georgia based domestic violence safe house. She earned her Masters of Social Work while interning with and eventually working part-time at the Atlanta Women's Foundation, an organization that works to create positive change in the lives of women and girls in Atlanta. In 2006, she joined Women's Resource Center where her main responsibilities are fundraising and marketing. Amber plans special events, serves as news media liaison, maintains the agency's three web sites, supports the development of partnerships, writes grants and solicitations, manages social media initiatives, manages major fund raisers such as the Champions for Change Luncheon, coordinates video production projects and supervises interns. Amber serves on the Board of Directors for Georgia Shares, a federation of non-profit organizations with a common mission of social justice for all Georgians, and on the Field Education Advisory Board for the Georgia State University School of Social Work. Amber has also appeared on a variety of radio and television programs to discuss issues pertaining to domestic violence and sexual assault.
