Hannah Green holds a B.A. in Sociology from Piedmont University and a Master of Social Work from the University of Georgia. During graduate school in 2017, Hannah joined the Women's Resource Center to End Domestic Violence as a social work intern where she had the opportunity to provide legal advocacy, crisis hotline support, and case management to domestic violence survivors. Upon graduating and earning the Licensed Master of Social Work credential, Hannah became a Foster Care Case Manager for the Georgia Division of Family & Children Services. She later served as Victim Advocate and Counselor for the Relationship & Sexual Violence Prevention Office at the University of Georgia. As part of this role, she provided individual trauma therapy and victim advocacy services to survivors of sexual assault, stalking, and domestic violence. She also served on the Sexual Assault Response Committees for UGA and the Western Judicial Circuit.
